



Bus Driver Position

A bus driver at Lititz Area Mennonite School must:

- Have an excellent driving record and great driving skills
- Be a team player
- Have a love for children and a concern for their safety
- Be accommodating to both patrons as well as school administration
- Be in good physical health
- Have the ability to work Monday through Friday both morning and afternoon

Qualifications

The driver must possess a general knowledge of the area; have skills in the safe operation of a vehicle, have the ability to detect malfunctioning equipment, have the ability to assist children using both patience and understanding, establish and maintain working relationships with school officials, patrons, school personnel, students and fellow drivers. Must have the ability to follow oral and written directions and have the ability to get along with others.

Education and Experience

Candidates must possess any combination of education and experience equal to the completion of high school and possess an excellent driving /safety record.

General Description

Transports school bus passengers between assigned stops and school according to specified route times schedules. Maintains order during the trip and adheres to the safety rules when loading and unloading passengers.

Special requirements:

- Candidate must be 21 years of age
- Candidate must satisfy the PA school bus physical
- Candidate must possess a CDL, including a "P" (passenger) and "S" (yellow card) endorsement
- Candidate must submit to child abuse, FBI, and PA State Police clearances
- Candidate must submit to pre-employment, random, and post-accident drug testing
- Candidate must possess good moral character, be trustworthy and reliable
