OUR MISSION

To provide a PreK-High School Christ-centered education within an Anabaptist framework to Christian families in our geographic area. Our academic program meets a variety of student needs in an environment that values the whole person.

WHAT DO THE TWO RATES MEAN?

The full-pay option reflects the true cost of educating a student and helps us bridge the gap between tuition revenue and actual expenses. The subsidized option is a rate that is available to all families and is offset by our two school-wide fundraisers, serve-a-thon and our auction.

HOW DOES THE SUBSIDIZED RATE WORK?

Thanks to generous donors and a robust EITC program, all families qualify for the subsidized rate as we try to keep the cost of Christian education affordable for everyone. Families who need additional financial support are encouraged to apply for needs-based aid through FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THESE RATES?

The displayed prices encompass both our enrollment and capital fees. Additionally, these rates cover the expenses for class field trips. However, please note that the new family application fee, transportation, hot lunch/pizza, and other elective options are not included. Our aim is to prevent any unexpected costs and ensure transparency in the pricing of your quality, Christ-Centered education.
